Figure 2	In notes to the figure, “emissions reductions of 88-95% by 2030” should refer to 2040 instead of 2030.
Figure 3	The notes to the figure refer to a lowest fair share estimate of -91 GtCO <sub>2</sub> from the start of 2020. This should read -99 GtCO <sub>2</sub>
Figure 5	In the notes to the figure, the labelling of consumption-based and territorial emissions reversed
7.2.5	Energy imports clarified to refer to net energy imports. Also corrected where referenced in summaries.
7.4	The reduction in CO <sub>2</sub> emissions from industrial processes between 2019 and 2040 corrected from 78-106% to 56-76%. The original figure referred to energy-related industrial emissions. Also corrected where referenced in summaries.
7.6	The range of methane reductions between 2019 and 2040 in the scenarios corrected from 39-47% to 35-50% in the wider Europe region, and from 18-39% to 15-40% for agriculture. The range of methane emissions from the demand-side focus scenario is clarified to be higher than these general ranges at 61%. Also corrected where referenced in summaries.
